

## How to open a bank account

## Step 1. Gather the following documents:

- Your Study Permit (IMM 1442), Temporary Resident Visa (TRV)
- One additional piece of government photo ID such as a passport or Canadian driver's license and Social Insurance Number (SIN)
- Proof of enrollment from your Canadian educational Institution such as your student ID card or your course timetable

## Step 2. Book an appointment with a bank representative by visiting or calling your respective bank branch to open an account.

## Step 3. Choose your account type(s)

When you meet your bank representative, discuss the account types, credit card, debit card, and advantages of the account type and how to build a credit score.

Set up one or more accounts. Most people have both chequing and savings accounts.

**Note:** Financial institutions are usually open during the day, Monday to Friday, and closed on holidays. Some branches are open in the evenings and on weekends.
